Host provides:

- Challah,
- All food (vegetarian, dairy, or pareve are acceptable),
- All drinks (except wine & juice),
- Paper napkins,
- If not using provided glass or Corelle dishware, then bring paper plates (our policy is to only allow those made with recycled content and biodegradable).

Host responsibilities:

- Set-up and cleanup of all food and drinks.
- Pour approx. 30 cups each of wine and grape juice (provided).
- Take all leftover paper goods and food with you when you leave.
- Find a replacement if you are unable to sponsor on the date you requested.
