

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## RELIGIOUS SCHOOL

Seaside Jewish Community Religious

School has a well-rounded curriculum that is implemented with a multi-sensory approach to learning. We admit students that will turn 5-years-old by January 1st. At this early stage in our development, we have two classes for Hebrew grouped by ability, and two classes for Judaic Studies grouped by age. Our teachers have experience with all grades and all subjects.



## BIBLE



We offer a two-tiered Bible curriculum. First, in the lower grades, we teach all of the major Bible stories. This instruction relies heavily on

puppets, which the students greatly enjoy. Then, in the upper grades, we have a two-year Bible curriculum. The first year focuses on stories from the Torah. The second year focuses on stories from the Prophets and Writing.

## HOLY DAYS

We offer a two-tiered Holy Day curriculum. First, in the lower grades, we teach all of the major Holy Days. This instruction relies heavily on wooden sets of ritual objects that



allow the students to experience the observance of the holiday. Then, in the upper grades, we have a one-year Holy Day curriculum. This

allows for a more in-depth study of the origin, history, observance, meaning and significance of the Holy Days.

## OTHER SUBJECTS

Other Judaic Studies subjects taught in the lower grades include God, Shabbat, Mitzvot, and Synagogue. Each of these subjects is a half-year curriculum.

Other Judaic Studies subject taught in the upper grades include My Jewish World, Lifecycle, and Israel. Each of these subjects is a full-year curriculum.

## MUSIC

The lower grades have music every week for the last fifteen minutes. We learn many Hebrew songs and some prayers. Every week we sing a song for the Israeli Flag and sing goodbye to our friends. The students really enjoy ending each week with music.



## HEBREW



We offer a prayer-based Hebrew curriculum that begins in kindergarten and culminates in B'nai

Mitzvah. We begin in the first year with learning the letters, which is followed by a pre-primer and a primer to get the students reading. Then, in the final three years we offer a three-year prayer-based curriculum. The first year focuses on blessings and the introductory prayers of the Shabbat morning service. The second year focuses on the Amidah prayer and its individual sections. The third year focuses on the Torah service and its songs and blessings, and the concluding prayers of the Shabbat morning service.
